

Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan – Architecture

- Four cross-cutting axes. Government economic policy strategy
 - I. Green Spain: National Integrated Energy and Climate Plan
 - II. Digital Spain: Agenda Digital Spain 202530% of the budget aprox. 20 BL €
 - III. Spain with no gender gaps
 - IV. Cohesive and inclusive Spain
- 10 structural reform levers: high capacity to drive activity and employment
- 30 components: coherent packages of investments and reforms
